

## KING'S MILL HOSPITAL NOTTINGHAMSHIRE

Women and Children's 'Envelope' nears completion.

The Women's and Children's building at King's Mill Hospital is nearing completion. This is the latest phase in the 114,000 sq m redevelopment of King's Mill Hospital. SHCA have been working on this PFI project since 2003, construction began in 2005, and the first phase of the new build, The King's Treatment Centre, was opened in 2008. Phase 2 was completed in March 2009 which included 2 towers of wards, plus day case theatres and recovery, pharmacy and endoscopy. The entire project is scheduled for completion in 2010.
